SCHOOL VISIT: PROJECT WORKSHOP

BACKGROUND	Gebert Rüf Stiftung considers the topic «Science and the public» meaningful not just in the context of its own sphere of activities, but practised as an integrated approach in general with all grant-making projects. The participation in the three projects «School visit: project workshop» and «Kursangebot Medientraining as defined in accordance with the support agreement (Art. 4 of the project-related regulations) must be placed in this context.
OBJECTIVE	Organising and making an afternoon visit

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

During the period the project is funded by Gebert Rüf Stiftung in accordance with the support agreement (Art. 3 of the project-related regulations), a senior school class at Gymnasium level must be visited as part of the project as stipulated in the project agreement.

1. Organisation

Project management organises and carries out the half-day visit, including contacting the class and inviting it. Rural schools are given preference. Any travelling expenses (public transport) are covered by Gebert Rüf Stiftung.

2. Project Goals

The visit is designed to give pupils the opportunity to gain insight into a specific higher education project and experience real scientific research.

Younger project members in particular will benefit from this visit as they are given the opportunity to present their project to interested laypersons. Because this part of the project requires some didactic simplification, it also forms a one-to-one part of «Science and the public».

3. Project Proof

As part of the project conclusion, evidence must be produced that pupils have visited as part of the «School visit: project workshop» project. The evidence may be in the form of a confirmation or appraisal by the accompanying teacher.
